Prepare a Term Calendar

At the beginning of a term, prepare a Term Calendar. Update it as the term goes on. Here is what to do to prepare a Term Calendar.

- Record your school assignments with their due dates and your scheduled tests.
- Record your planned school activities.

- Record your known out-of-school activities.

Prepare a Weekly Schedule

Each Sunday before a school week, prepare a Weekly Schedule. Update it as the week goes on. Here is what to do to prepare a Weekly Schedule.

- Record your daily classes
- Enter things to be done for the coming week from your Term Calendar
- Review your class notes from the previous week to see if you need to add any school activities
- Add any out-of-school

These times may be during the school day, right after school, evenings, and weekends

Prepare a Daily Organizer

Each evening before a school day, prepare a Daily Organizer for the next day. Place a ✓ next to each thing to do as you accomplish it. Here is what to do to prepare a Daily Organizer.

- Enter the things to do for the coming day from your weekly Schedule.
- Enter the things that still

Need to be accomplished from your Daily Organizer from the previous day

- Review your class notes for the day just completed to see if you need to add any school activities
- Add any out-of-school activities in which you will be involved the next day.

Your Weekly Schedule should have more detail than Your Term Calendar. Your Daily Organizer should have more detail than your Weekly Schedule. Using a Term Calendar, a Weekly Schedule, and a Daily Organizer will help you make the best use of your time. We wish you all the best in your studies!!!!

Negative Effects Of Smoking

Whether you smoke 5 cigarettes a day or 50, there is no doubt that smoking is extremely bad for you and will seriously affect your health in some way.

Smoking cigarettes can harm almost every organ in your body, from top to bottom and inside and out. Moreover, it is only now that doctors are beginning to discover the true extent of the harm that smoking can cause to a person's health and to the health of those around him.



Smoking over a prolonged period of time can cause a number of serious diseases and illnesses, some fatal and others that will not kill you but will leave you with a poorer quality of life in general.

Usually a person takes up smoking when they are young and the effects that smoking may have on their

health does not enter their head at the time. Within a short while, they will become addicted to nicotine and it will be too late to give up. The younger a person starts to smoke, the greater the health risks they will face later on in life.

The majority of people who die from smoking will have suffered from one of three main diseases: lung cancer, coronary heart disease or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. The main health risks in tobacco smoking pertain to diseases of the respiratory tract (particularly lung cancer) and

What're the Health Effects Of Smoking?

also to diseases of the cardiovascular system, in particular smoking being a major risk factor for a myocardial infarction (heart attack). Cancers of the larynx and tongue are also important causes of mortality and morbidity

Heart:

The effects of cigarette smoking on the cardiovascular system are multi-fold: Smoking lowers HDL cholesterol ("good" cholesterol). Those who smoke a pack of cigarettes a day have almost two and a half times the risk for having a stroke as nonsmokers.

Cancer:

Smoking is the cause of nearly 85 percent of all cases of lung cancer, but smoking accounts for other types of cancers as well. Smokers have higher rates of leukemia, and cancers of the stomach, bladder, kidney and pancreas. About 30 percent of cervical cancers have been attributed to smoking.

Bones and joints:

Smoking has many negative effects on bones and joints since it impairs formation of new bone. Women who smoke are at an exceptionally high risk for developing osteoporosis. Smokers are also more disposed to developing degenerative disorders

injuries in the spine.

Bad skin:

It can prevent oxygen and nutrients from getting to the skin - which is why smokers often appear pale and unhealthy.



Bad Breath:

All those cigarettes leave smokers with a condition called halitosis, or persistent bad breath.

Bad-smelling clothes and hair:

The smell of stale smoke tends to linger - not just on people's clothing, but on their hair, furniture, and cars. And it's often hard to get the smell of smoke out.

Greater risk of injury and slower healing time:



Smoking affects the body's ability to produce collagen, so common sports injuries, such as damage to tendons and ligaments will heal more slowly in smokers than nonsmokers.

Smoking commonly begins with teens that start smoking because they believe it makes them seem more mature, cool, and rebellious or because they believe that it helps them relax. Unfortunately smoking is addictive. Beginning smoking as a teen will lead to a long life of bad problems and if you don't smoke, and don't start you will save yourself from death.

Cloning

We all know that nobody can create living organisms with a soul other than the creator himself. However, some people have attempted to do so. Cloning has many forms. However, "Human Cloning" is considered to be the most interesting. Human cloning is the creation of a genetically identical copy of a human cell or human tissue. The ethics of cloning is an extremely controversial issue.

The term is generally used to refer to artificial human cloning; human clones in the form of identical twins are commonplace with their cloning occurring during the natural process of reproduction. There are two commonly discussed types of human

cloning: Therapeutic Cloning and Reproductive Cloning. Therapeutic Cloning involves cloning cells from an adult for use in medicine and is in an active area of research, while reproductive would involve making cloned humans. Such reproductive cloning has not been performed and is illegal in many countries. A third type of cloning called Replacement Cloning is a theoretical Cloning is a

theoretical possibility, and would be a combination of therapeutic and reproductive cloning. Replacement cloning would entail the replacement of an extensively damaged, failed, or failing body through cloning followed by a whole partial brain transplant. Fever in Children

You've probably experienced waking in the middle of the night to find your child flushed, hot, and sweaty. Your little one's forehead feels warm. You immediately suspect a fever, but are unsure of what to do next. Should you get out the thermometer? Call the doctor?

In healthy kids, fevers usually don't indicate anything serious. Although it can be frightening when your child's temperature rises, fever itself causes no harm and can actually be a good thing — it's often the body's way of fighting infections. And not all fevers need to be treated. High fever, how-

ever, can make a child uncomfortable and worsen problems such as dehydration.

It's important to remember that fever by itself is not an illness — it's usually a symptom of an underlying problem. Fever has a few potential causes.



Infection: Most fevers are caused by infection or other illness. Fever helps the body fight infections by stimulating natural defense mechanisms.

Overdressing: Infants, especially newborns, may get fevers if they're over bundled or in a hot environment because they don't regulate their body temperature as well as older kids. However, because fevers in newborns can indicate a serious infection, even infants who are overdressed must be evaluated by a doctor if they have a fever.

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Immunizations: Babies and kids sometimes get a low-grade fever after getting vaccinated.

Teething: It may cause a slight rise in body temperature, but it's probably not the cause if a child's temperature is higher than 37.8°C

When Fever Is a Sign of Something Serious?


If your child is between 3 months and

3 years old and has a fever of 39°C or higher, call your doctor to see if he or she needs to see your child. For older kids, take behavior and activity level into account. The illness is probably **not** serious if your child:

- Is still interested in playing.
- Is eating and drinking well.
- Has a normal skin color.
- Looks well when his or her temperature comes down.
- Don't worry too much about a child with a fever who doesn't want to eat. This is very common with infections that cause fever. For kids who still drink and urinate normally, not eating as much as usual is OK.

Is it a Fever?

- Use a reliable thermometer to confirm a fever (which is when a child's temperature is at or above one of these levels):
- 38°C measured rectally (in the bottom).
- 37.5°C measured orally (in the mouth).
- 37.2°C measured in an auxiliary position (under the arm).



Types of Thermometers:

Whatever thermometer you choose, be sure you know how to use it correctly to get an accurate reading. Keep and follow the manufacturer's recommendations for any thermometer.

Digital thermometers, Electronic ear thermometers, Plastic strip thermometers, Forehead thermometers, Pacifier thermometers, Glass mercury thermometers.

When to Call the Doctor?

The exact temperature that should

trigger a call to the doctor depends on the age of the child, the illness, and whether there are the following symptoms .

Blue lips, tongue, or nails.

Infant's soft spot on the head seems to be bulging outward or sunken inward.

Stiff neck, Severe headache, Limpness or refusal to move, Difficulty breathing that doesn't get better when the nose is cleared, Leaning forward and drooling, Seizures, Abdominal pain.

Prevention of Fever:

The best way to prevent fevers is to reduce exposure to infectious diseases.

Teach your children to vigorously wash their hand and to carry hand sanitizer When they don't have access to soap and water.

In addition, teach your children to turn away from others and to cover their mouths when coughing and their noses when sneezing. When possible, teach your kids not to touch their noses, mouths or eyes — the main way viral infections are transmitted. Your child's wellbeing is crucial please be sure to comfort and take care of them.








K.G. Horseback Riding Trip



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
